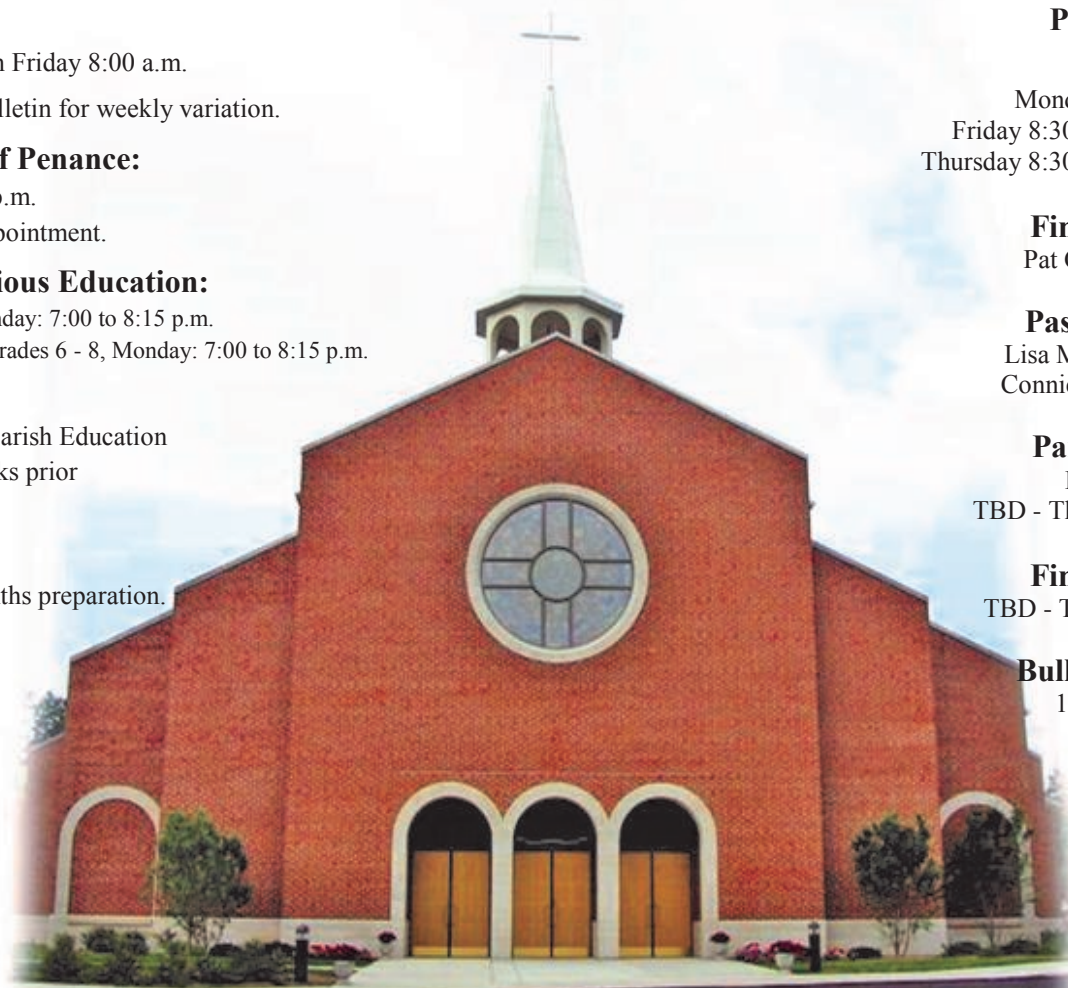

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ANTHONY.....

Our parish has been promoting the **FORMED** Program for several months now. Have you noticed? FORMED is an opportunity to learn about our Catholic faith and to grow in faith. This program is free for all of our parishioners. We are investigating various ways that we can use the FORMED Resources communally; however, individuals can already use the resources. Parishioners need to sign up for FORMED at www.htligonier.formed.org. Please take a look at the web page and start using the resources there. Also, you have probably noticed the kiosk with books and cassette disks in the gathering space – this is part of FORMED. I truly hope you will investigate what our parish is offering through FORMED.

I have mentioned PATHWAYS in this space a few times in the past. PATHWAYS is “an adult faith formation initiative of the Diocese of Greensburg.” In the gathering space of the church, you will find information concerning the 2019-2020 PATHWAYS sessions. If you are interested in attending PATHWAYS, the parish will subsidize the cost of the program for you. I encourage all parishioners from high school age up to participate in PATHWAYS. I hope you will consider this.

Looking for a way to serve the parish? We are in need of collection counters. Please let us know if you would be interested in serving the parish in this way.

Mike Dargay, a candidate for the diaconate here in the Diocese of Greensburg, has begun his series “Biblical Walk through the Mass.” Mike will offer the sessions on Saturday evenings after Mass, and again on Sunday mornings beginning at 9:30AM. All are welcome to join one of these groups.

Do you like to read? I would like to start a book group – perhaps we can read a book from the FORMED kiosk – and then meet once a month to have a discussion about it. However, we don’t have to limit ourselves to the FORMED content. I am thinking that this would begin in September. Look for more details soon.

As of Thursday, June 27, our parish DLA had received gifts from 169 parishioners and had reached \$67,995. We are \$19,691 over the diocesan goal. Thanks to all who are participating.
