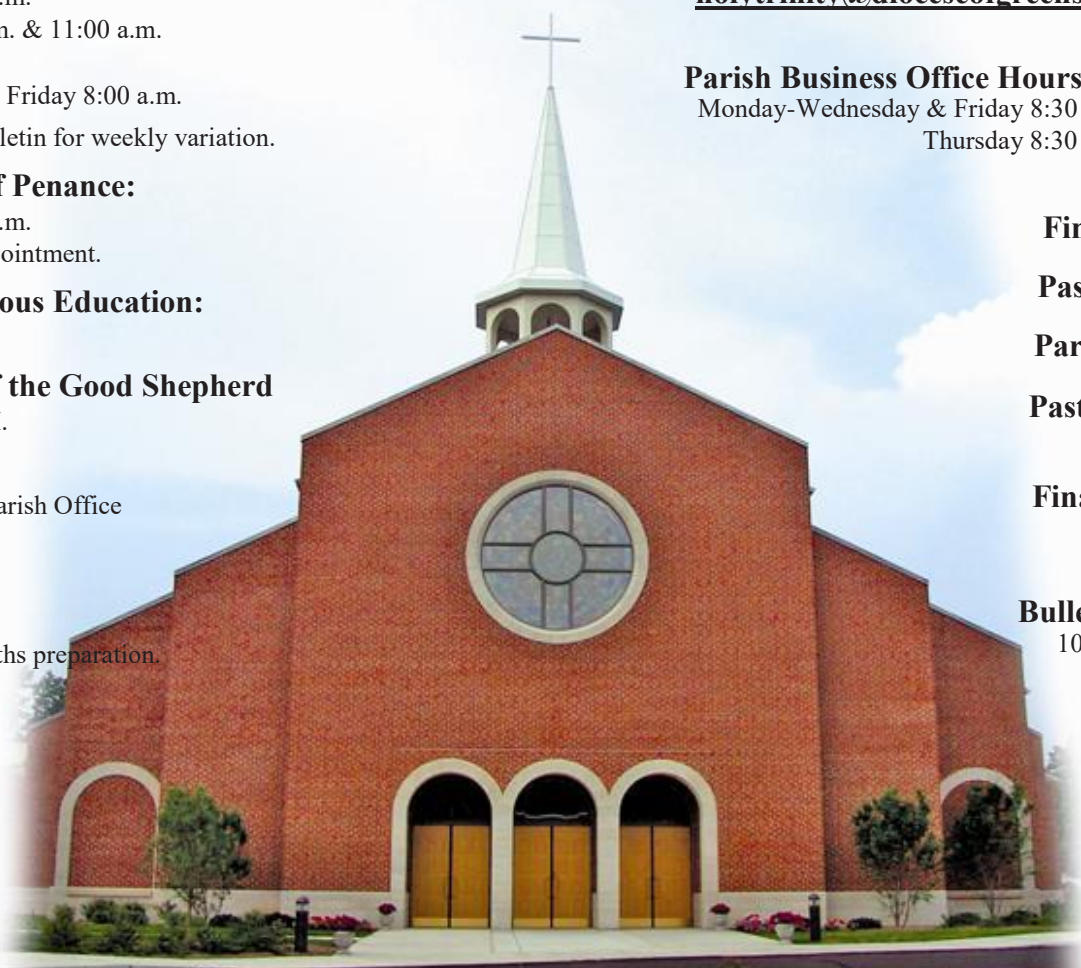

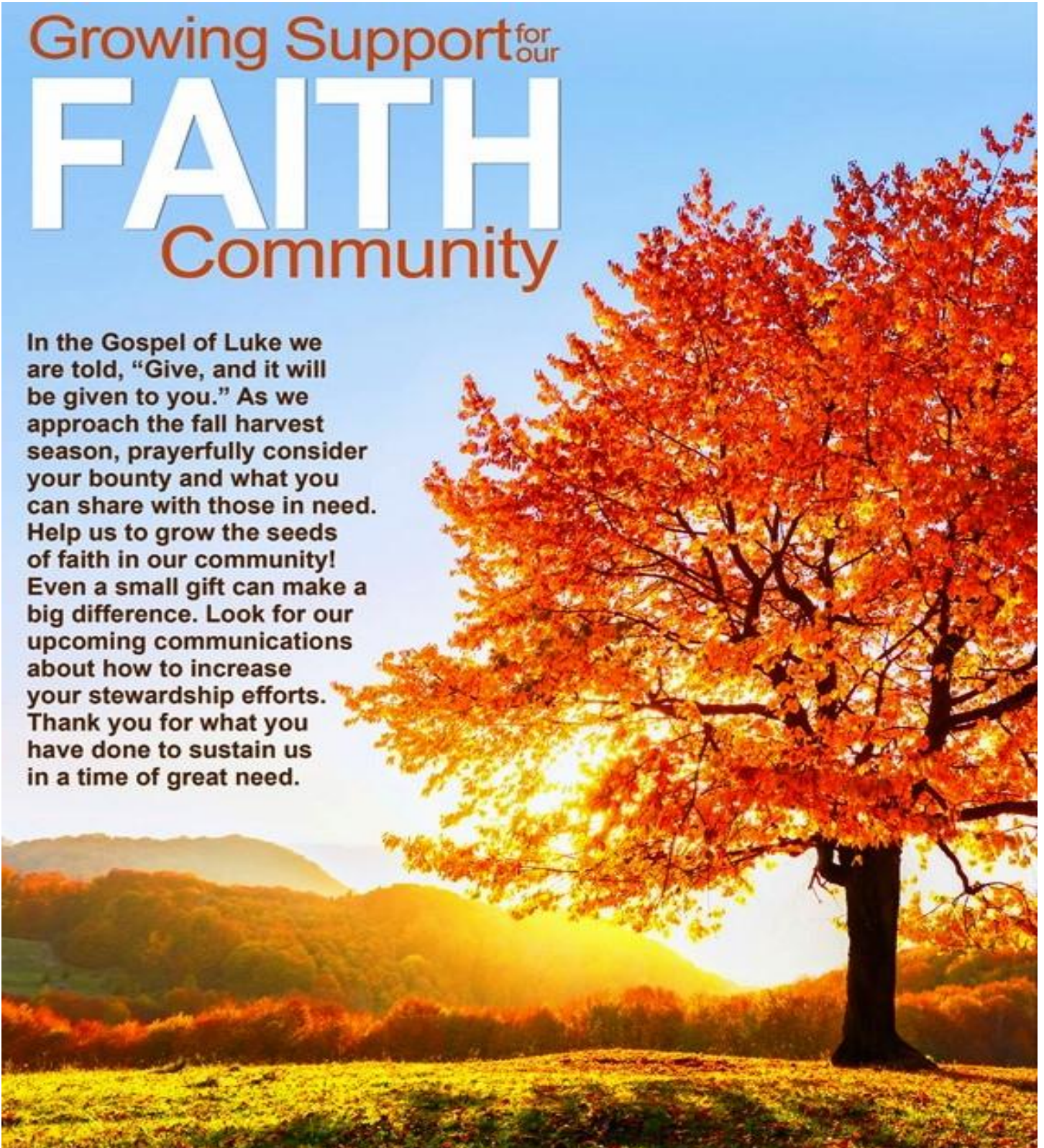

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ANTHONY.....

“We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard.” This is the theme for World Mission Sunday 2021, which we celebrate today. ***World Mission Sunday*** is an annual celebration in the Church which reminds us of the very reason the Church exists. We proclaim the Good News to all of humanity. Our efforts begin with prayer, but then we must also put our prayer into action. Some of the baptized are called to go to distant lands, while most of us strive to evangelize in our homes, schools, places of work, and wherever else we might be. The second envelope today is for the World Missions. The Society for the Propagation of the Faith will disburse the proceeds of today’s collection throughout the world, offering aid and assistance to over 1,000 mission dioceses. The Society reminds us, “The collection today ... ensures the work and service of the Mission Church, as it supports priests, religious and lay leaders who offer the Lord’s mercy and concrete help to the most vulnerable communities in the Pope’s missions.” Your gifts support and sustain priests, religious and lay pastoral leaders in more than 1,100 mission dioceses in Asia, Africa, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe as they proclaim the Gospel build the Church, serve the poor — and speak of our shared faith in all corners of the world. ***Thank you for your generous response to the needs of the Missions!*** Consider offering this prayer throughout the week: ***“O God, whose will it is that all should be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth, look upon your abundant harvest and be pleased to send workers to gather it, that the Gospel may be preached to all creation and that your people, gathered by the word of life and sustained by the power of the Sacraments, may advance in the path of salvation and love. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.”***

Don’t forget that October is the month of the Holy Rosary and also Respect Life Month. Offer a Rosary that all human life will be protected and be given greater respect from the moment of conception.
