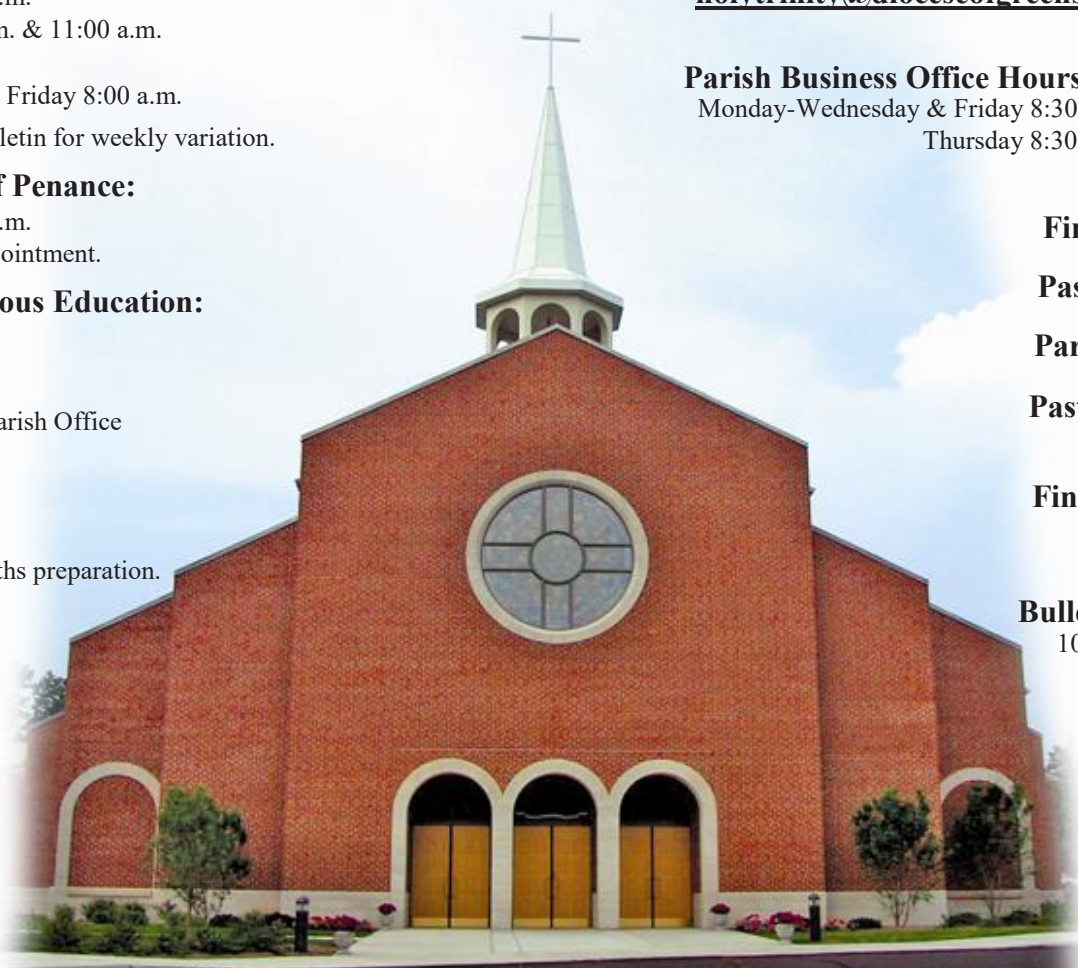

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ANTHONY.....

Just a reminder to our parents of children in grades one through eight! Faith Formation has begun and the next meeting is tomorrow, September 20, beginning at 6:00PM. It is not too late to register. I hope that all eligible children will be participating in Faith Formation this year.

Although school has started again and many fall activities are in full swing, the first day of autumn comes this Wednesday, September 22, at 3:21PM. I am sure you have noticed the days getting “shorter” since the first day of summer. After the equinox there will be more dark than light – that is, the amount of time that the sun shines in our hemisphere will be shorter than the time that darkness surrounds us. And yet we are people who trust in the True Light – Jesus Christ – as we profess in the Creed – “God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God.” May we allow the Lord’s Light to shine through us as we strive to be good and holy children of Light.
